CONTENT AND STRUCTURE


- Start strong: Begin with an engaging hook to capture the reader's attention.

- Demonstrate passion: Convey enthusiasm for your field of study and future plans.
- Research the scholarship provider: Align your statement with the organisation's values and mission.
- Be forward-looking: Emphasise your future potential and how the scholarship will help.
- Address setbacks positively: Explain how you've overcome challenges and what you've learned.
